

Let's Talk: Runaway Prevention Curriculum Remote Facilitation Tip Sheet

Let's Talk: Runaway Prevention Curriculum is a free, evidence-based, interactive, 14 module curriculum intended to educate young people about alternatives to running away as well as to build life skills so that youth can resolve problems without resorting to running away or unsafe behavior.

Let's Talk is primarily designed for youth ages 10-20, but is easily adapted to other age groups. Let's Talk is also designed to be supremely userfriendly for instructors. Each module gives instructors all the necessary information, including worksheets that go along with each activity and pre and post-tests. The curriculum can be used in any number of settings, including schools, youth groups, community centers, and even online!

Below are some tips to facilitate activities online:

- 1. Host activities virtually via an online meeting platform. It can be helpful to utilize the camera and chat feature to engage the group in online discussions.
- 2. Convert Let's Talk activity content to an online slide presentation instead of handouts.
- 3. Create short videos or infographics to explain concepts.
- 4. Utilize online whiteboards to create posters and capture group answers.
- 5. Modify appropriate activities to an online game format.
